BAMUNDI MAHAVIDYALAYA : A BRIEF PROFILE

Bamundi Mahavidyalaya was established on 20th December 1997. It is the only institution of higher education in the locality. The people of Bamundi started this institution with the aim of imparting higher education to the wards of this village as the people of this area are not able to send their wards to some distant educational institution for economic reason. Most of the students are coming from the families of farmers, fishermen, daily wage earning, small traders etc. and many of them falls below poverty line. Bamundi Mahavidyalaya is one of the most important educational institutions of the locality catering to the educational needs of the poor and marginalized section of the society. Without this institution the aspiration of these students to receive higher education will remain unfulfilled. Thus for the poor and rural community of Bamundi, which is located in the foothill of Hatimura Pahar in the district of Kamrup under Soalkuchi police station, Bamundi Mahavidyalaya has been offering a great service.

Bamundi Mahavidyalaya was affiliated to Gauhati University permanently from the session of 2010 -2011 vide letter no E.C.Res.No.R/EC- 06/2011/3(B) (15) Dated 07/12/11. Since inception, the college has been trying to collect funds by providing the excess college land on lease for various community services including one fishery. The college has 19 bighas 2 kathas and 11 lechas of land covering the classrooms, administrative building, library, teachers' common room, canteen and a playground.

Since the beginning the college has been offering undergraduate programmes in Arts. Besides, the college has the aim to introduce some career oriented course and vocational education.
